

VeilBreakers™ Partnership Packet

Subtitle: Book + Workshops + Angel Torch (Film/TV)

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Executive Summary

VeilBreakers: The Hidden War is a YA novel and transmedia IP paired with a trauma-informed, story-driven workshop program for teens and young adults. The workshops translate the book's core themes—**mercy over dominance**, truthful identity, chosen courage—into practical skills youth can use the same day. Hosts may optionally enable a **faith-forward track** that teaches age-appropriate listening prayer (learning to hear the Lord's voice) and tests impressions in community and Scripture with clear guardrails. The approach aligns with established trauma-informed practice and leverages narrative and interactive learning to increase engagement.

Why Now — The Youth Well-Being Case

- Global: **~1 in 7 adolescents** lives with a mental disorder; anxiety/depression are leading causes of illness/disability.
- Canada: 2019–2025 trend snapshots show continued strain in youth mental health.
Implication: prevention-oriented supports that build hope, coping, belonging, and ethical decision-making complement clinical services and crisis response.

What We Offer — Program Pillars

1. **Trauma-Informed Environment** – Safety; trust & transparency; peer support; collaboration & mutuality; empowerment/voice/choice; cultural humility/history—embedded in norms, facilitation, reflection.
2. **Story → Skills** – Short, cinematic scenes from *VeilBreakers* lead into guided dialogue on courage, mercy, truthful choices, identity.
3. **Game-Informed Practice** – Choice paths, team “quests,” reflection cards; small-to-moderate positive learning effects in the research.
4. **Restorative Orientation** – Circles and repair-minded prompts strengthen belonging/accountability.
5. **Faith-Forward (Opt-In): Identity & Voice** – Where requested (churches/faith schools/chaplaincy; public partners that opt-in), we teach simple listening-prayer and identity-in-Christ language with strict non-coercive boundaries; always voluntary; Scripture-tested.

Signature Micro-Practice

Resonance — “Two Taps, One Breath.” Tap-tap on thigh or chair; one slow breath; ask quietly (“Lord, what do You want me to know right now?” “Who do You say I am?”); choose the loving, lawful, and wise next action.

- **Public-sector variant:** taught as neutral self-regulation (no devotional language).
- **Faith-forward variant:** voluntary listening-prayer (clear safeguards, no pressure).

Book-Linked Modules (Act I-III tie-ins)

- **Resonance — Tune Before You Move** (*two taps + breath*)
- **The Tunnel Effect — Peace That Trains Courage**
- **The Price of Names — Prayer vs. Control**
- **Mercy & Steel — Discernment Under Pressure**
- **Casting Crowns — Laying Down Lesser Thrones**
- **The Broken Face — Authority Through Surrendered Wounds**

Each module maps to scenes/themes in *VeilBreakers* to reinforce memory, identity, and mercy-over-power through short labs, prompts, and challenge cards.

Outcomes We Target (and Measure)

- Stronger identity and hopeful future orientation
- Practical coping (breathing/grounding; cognitive reframing)
- Prosocial bonds and conflict de-escalation
- Growth in ethical reasoning and service mindset

Measurement: brief pre/post check-ins (hope/identity; coping confidence; belonging), session feedback, and alignment to indicators you already track (attendance, referrals/incidents). We provide a concise outcomes snapshot and next-step recommendations.

Delivery Formats

- **Schools & Youth Orgs:** 4–8 sessions (45–60 min).
- **Detention/Justice:** 6–10 compact modules + restorative circles; chaplaincy-aligned faith track (voluntary).
- **One-Day Intensives/Retreats:** launch event + leader-ready micro-lessons.
- **Train-the-Facilitator:** equips staff/volunteers for faithful delivery.

Safeguarding, Consent, Inclusion

Vulnerable Sector Checks; Rule-of-Two supervision; privacy/recording by meaningful consent. No pressure, no “performing” spirituality, no trauma-sharing at a microphone; warm hand-offs to

on-site professionals. Public-sector variant is values-based and non-devotional; any prayer step is clearly labeled and voluntary.

Implementation & Reporting (Pilot Model)

Phase 1 – Scope: co-design goals, schedule, and consent language.

Phase 2 – Deliver: 4–8 sessions (or detention-ready micro-modules).

Phase 3 – Report: outcome snapshot (pre/post signals), youth/leader feedback, recommended follow-ons (journal pathway; Train-the-Facilitator).

Investment Snapshot (Typical)

- **Assembly (50–60 min):** run-of-show + student take-home card + leader one-pager.
- **Half-Day Intensive:** main talk + 2 modules; small-group prompts; pre/post templates.
- **Full-Day/Retreat:** teaching + labs + guided response; leader coaching block.
- **Premium Add-On: Identity & Voice Lab** (Train-the-Trainer + chaplaincy alignment, ~6 hours total) that launches a six-week journal pathway.
(Honorarium + travel; bursaries available for underserved groups.)

Partners & Funding Paths (Canada-forward examples)

Public/independent/faith-based schools; alternative/continuation schools; municipal/provincial youth services; Ministries of Education/Health/Children & Family Development; provincial youth-justice centres; probation/parole; Correctional Service Canada (via chaplaincy); Indigenous-serving organizations and friendship centres; youth shelters and transitional-living programs; YMCAs/YWCAs, libraries; churches/camps and city-gospel movements.

The Transmedia Advantage — Angel Torch (Film/TV)

Logline: In a future fractured by engineered memory, a wounded young leader learns that surrender to the One True Voice—not dominance—is the only way to cut through the Veil and rescue the girl who can unmake it.

Why It Adapts: iconic world (Citadel of Embers; Veil fractures), romance-with-restraint, mercy-over-power engine, grounded VFX logic.

Teaser Plan (90 seconds): gym/hall + small industrial room + one exterior night; minimal CG (Veil ripple, glyph glow); tonal “hum” motif.

Proof of Audience: workshops (faith-based and trauma-informed), website/press kit, early partner interest.
